Eligibility Requirements

The Karn Nichols Passion and Purpose Award will be awarded to:

- A high school student currently enrolled in Grade 12 or recent graduate (no more than 3 years since graduating or receiving GED).
- Enrolled in post-secondary education at a College or University.
- Demonstrates helping others and making a difference to those around them.
- Regularly contributes to their community, as demonstrated by long-term commitment and leadership as a volunteer, student, artist and/or athlete.
- A focus and awareness as to how passion and purpose intersects in their lives.



Selection Criteria

- A short essay (500 words min.), or a piece of art in the medium of your choice (painting, drawing, song, script, etc.) that outlines your financial situation and the importance of the bursary for you.
- A letter of acceptance from the post-secondary institution you will be attending.

Application Checklist

- Official High School **Transcripts**
- Official **letter of acceptance** from post-secondary institute
- A **short essay** (500 words min.), or a **piece of art** in the medium of your choice (painting, drawing, song, script, etc.) that outlines your financial situation and the importance of the bursary for you.
